

Committee Member Job Description

Overview: Due to the great success of the First Annual Teacher Excellence Fund Telethon last year, Great Hearts will be hosting its Second Annual Teacher Excellence Fund Telethon to raise money for Great Hearts Arizona teachers. The Telethon will not be successful without a dedicated committee member from each academy.

Goal: Raise \$500,000 for the Great Hearts Arizona 2021 Teacher Excellence Fund to be distributed to teachers, based on merit, in their December 2021 payroll.

Criteria: An individual/couple whose identification with the Telethon will increase its significance in the minds of the Great Hearts community. Someone who has a genuine appreciation for their school, Great Hearts, the purpose of the event, and can articulate the details and needs of the Teacher Excellence Fund.

Time Commitment: February 2021 – October 2021

Responsibilities: To provide motivational leadership to the extended community in support of the Telethon. To help set the message, tone, and strategy for maximum participation from the families, corporations, vendors, etc.

Expectations:

Event Planning

- 1. Attend monthly planning meetings at the GH Home Office at 4801 East Washington Street, Suite 250, Phoenix, AZ 85034
- 2. Lead and/or serve on a sub-committee of your choice
- 3. Work with Office Managers, Academy Giving Managers, PSO, class parents and Headmasters to actively promote the Telethon at the academy level
- 4. Coordinate with Headmasters and Academy Giving Manager to plan and record campus broadcast segment
- 5. Assist with program planning: securing students and teachers to be involved and offering your ideas and suggestions to make the Telethon engaging and widely known among parents, volunteers, and the larger community
- 6. Be available for set-up the day before the Telethon
- 7. Serve as an Advisory Committee Member for future committee members (see description below)



Fundraising

- 1. Procure at least one sponsorship or donation of \$5,000 or above
- 2. Solicit in-kind donations as needed, i.e. volunteer meals, printing services, etc.
- 3. Allow your name to be used on fundraising and marketing pieces created by Great Hearts
- 4. Brainstorm and solicit audience incentives to drive day-of donations, i.e. "\$500 or more gets a bottle of wine donated by X family/company"

Volunteer Involvement and Recruitment

- 1. Secure at least 15 volunteers from your school community to serve on Telethon Day, i.e. Prep students, PSOs, parents, etc.
- 2. Volunteer for at least one 2-hour Phone Banking shift on the day-of the Telethon

Benefits of Service:

- Name listed on all event collateral; distribution 30,000+ GH parents and corporate partners
- Invitation to Sponsor Appreciation Luncheon with Great Hearts America CEO Jay Heiler (post-event, date TBD)
- Opportunities to engage with Great Hearts Arizona President Erik Twist and other leadership team members
